

INFORMATION ON THE LEGAL STATUS OF THE SOCIETY

The Missionary Society of St. Columban (a.k.a. St. Columban's Foreign Mission Society, a.k.a. Columban Fathers) is a not-for-profit corporation organized for religious, educational and charitable purposes, and as such is exempt from Federal Income Tax under §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

The exemption of the Missionary Society of St. Columban is derived from its listing in *The Official Catholic Directory**. The Internal Revenue Service recognizes this directory as showing the names and addresses of all agencies and instrumentalities and all educational, charitable and religious institutions operated by the Roman Catholic Church in the United States, its' territories and possessions in existence at the time the directory was published. It is understood that each of these is a not-for-profit organization, that no part of the net earnings thereof inures to the benefit of any individual, that no substantial part of their activities is for the promotion of legislation, and that none are private foundations under §509(a) of the Code.

Charitable contributions made to the Society by our benefactors are deductible as provided in Section 170 of the Code.

Bequests, legacies, devises, transfers or gifts are deductible for Federal Estate and Gift Tax purposes under the provisions of Section 2055 and 2106.


In the State of Nebraska, the Society is incorporated under two separate titles:
